A fine old color example of De Jode's fine map of the Holy Land.

The map is based upon the map of Tilemannus Stella and is oriented with west at the top. The shore line is irregular and runs from Tirus to Beerseba. The Dead Sea is a crescent shape. There is a view of modern Jerusalem at the bottom, and two illustrations, the Chapel of the Nativity in Bethlehem and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. The views are based upon work by Fernando Bertelli.
