

Striking full color example of Tallis's town plan of York.

Includes vignettes of The Minster, Walmgate Bar, Archbishop's Palace, The Castle, Museum, Railway Station, Micklegate Bar, Ruins of St. Mary's Abbey, Guildhall and Ousebridge.

One of the most decorative and sought after town plans of the City to appear in an atlas in the 19th Century. Engraved for R. Montgomery Martin's Illustrated Atlas.

Tallis was one of the last great decorative map makers. His maps are prized for the wonderful vignettes of indigenous scenes, people, etc. The town plans engraved by Tallis appear in only a small percentage of his works, making them harder to obtain than his regional maps.
