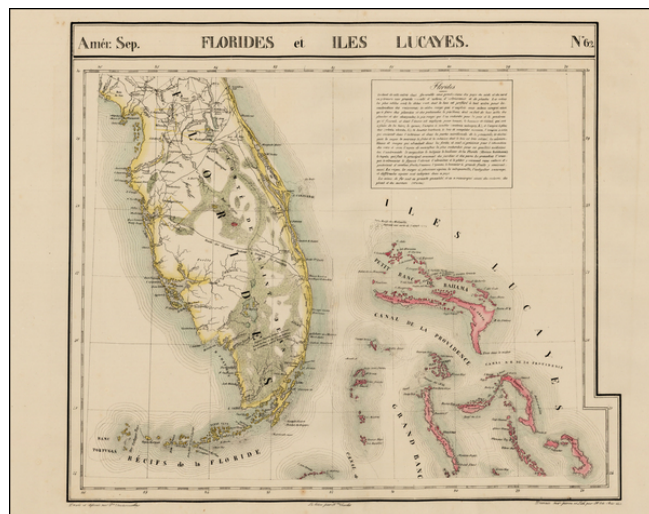

Fine example of the second edition early map of Florida and the Bahamas, exhibiting tremendous detail for the period.

The map shows early roads in Florida, the Indian Trail which traverses the peninsula, annotations on the Everglades and many place names. Several early early colonies are noted. Excellent detail in the Keys.

The second edition includes credits below the neat line and is completely re-engraved, adding populations in little yellow and red ovals.

From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
