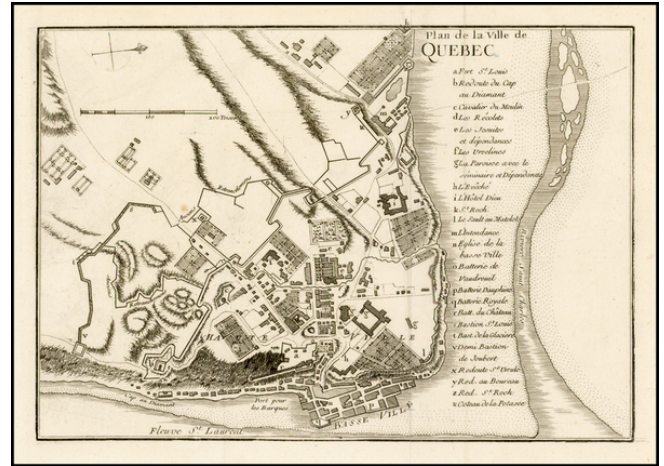

Fine example of Le Rouge's plan of Quebec, issued at the beginning of at the outset of the French & Indian War in his *Recueil des plans de l'Amerique septentrionale*.

The map shows a detailed plan of Quebec, including a key locating approximately 25 points of interest within the City, including a number of fortifications.

The map is extremely rare, this being the first example we have seen on the market in 20 years.
