

## **Description:**

Nice example of Brion de la Tour's early map of the United States, one of the earliest obtainable maps to name the US.

The map show the British Colonies, but limits them to the region east of the Alleghanys & Appalachians. The west remains French & Indian, with forts, settlements, Indian tribes, etc. Nicely detailed & important map. Still no Vermont. Detroit is shown. The Country of the Six Nations is shown, as are a number of early Western Forts.
