and showing the Spanish Intendencies of San Luis Potosi, New Mexico, Durango and Sonora, among others. Wonderful detail.

Includes the mythical lakses of Timanagos and Teguayo on the River Buenaventura, which reached from SF Bay to Salt Lake. The Carnacaways Indians are shown in Texas, as is St. Antonio and St. Jose, along with Galveston, Loredo, Mier and other early place names. Many Indian names included.
