

Roads, towns, rivers, and lakes included on map. Flags indicate six "places remarkable for battles and sieges". Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827.
