Gorgeous example of Buchon's map of Texas, Upper California and Mexico, from the French edition version Carey & Lea's *American Atlas*.

Both Lake Timpanagos and Teguayo are shown, with still a hint of a river flowing from Monterrey to Teguayo. Nice detail in the Provincia de Texas, an early appearance of the name.

The Rocky Mountains are a single cordillera, after Humboldt's model. Excellent detail along the upper Rio Grande, although beyond Taos, the River is probably pure speculation. The California Missions are shown as are the Sierra Nevada Mountains.
