

Key notes flags for five remarkable battles. Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827. The French edition is generally the most highly regarded, in terms of the quality of the paper and engraving.
