

Highly detailed sea chart of the Shantung (Shandong) Province, published by the British Admiralty.

The chart provides a highly detailed treatment of the region, from Kyau-Chau Bay (Jiaozhuo Bay) and the Qingdao area to Miaodoa Strait in the North and the area near Froung Island.

The area is shown in the era shortly after the Second Boxer Rebellion, when Western Trade in the region was greatly expanding. Later in the 19th Century, Quindao (Tsingtao) would be leased to Germany in 1897 and Weihai to Britain in 1898.
