A Fine Map of California Issued During The First Major Land Boom in Southern California

One of the best large format maps of California published in the 1880s, during a period of explosive growth and land speculation in Southern California.

The railroads are shown in exceptional detail, with every station in the state named.

Southern California consists of only 5 counties (Los Angeles, San Diego, San Bernardino, Ventura, and Santa Barbara), with Ventura no longer called Buenaventura.

A massive Tulare Lake is still shown.

The tables include significant information, including details on California's Counties, agriculture, coal mining, etc.



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The map is quite rare on the market, this being the first example we have ever offered.
