Fine example of Sanson's 1641 double-page engraved map of the Duchy of Cleves. The map follows the course of the Rhine River between Worms and Arnhem, just over the Dutch - German border. The map was published by Nicolas Sanson in Paris in 1648.

The map is highly detailed, naming a great many cities, towns, rivers, and more. Cities named include Aachen, Dusseldorf, Cologne, Duigsburg, Bonn, and Mainz. Special geographical attention is paid to geographical features such as forests and mountains, typical of Sanson's maps. In all, the map is fine and attractive.
