An Important Modern Charting of Southwestern Patagonia

Fine chart of the western part of the Straits of Magellan and the southern part of Chile, extending north to the Reserva Nacional Alcalufes and Desolation Island.

The sea chart was first issued in November or December of 1870, with improvements up to 1879, coming from the Chilean Government.



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The chart includes insets of:

- Lattitude Cove
- Coumbine Cove
- Caracciolo Bay
- Dixon Cove
- Occasion Cove

Includes several profile views.

The chart is rare on the market. This is the first example we hvae seen on the market.
