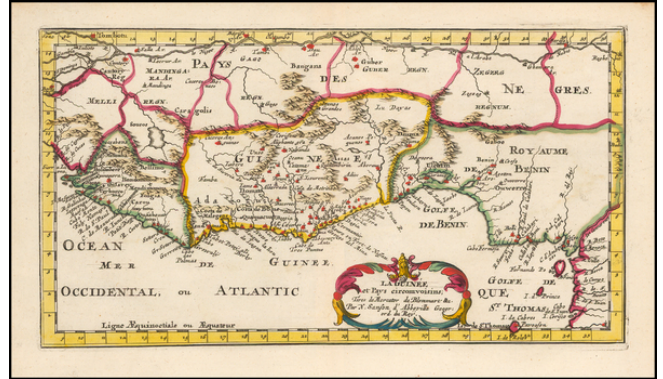

Fine old color example of this finely engraved map of western part of Sub-Saharan Africa, first published by Nicholas Sanson in 1654.

The map extends from modern day Liberia to Gabon, including parts of Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana, Togo, Benin, Nigeria, Equatorial Guinea and Cameroon.

Sanson was the Royal Geographer to the King of France and perhaps the most important commercial mapmaker of his generation.
