Its railway lines are confined to Luzon, extending from San Fernando, La Union, in the north, to Legaspi, Albay, in the south, with a number of branches serving areas far from the main lines. The more important branches are the Paniqui-San Quintin, Tarlac-San Jose, Bigaa-Cabanatuan, San Fernando-Carmen, Calamba-Batangas, and College-Pagsanjan.

Provenance: Jose Paez, who was appointed the first Filipino General Manager of the Manila Railroad Company on October 5, 1923 and would later rise to the position of President of the Railroad.
