Fine example of Cary's map of the United States, shortly before the War of 1812.

Includes a massive Georgia, extending to the Mississippi River, East and West Florida, the District of Maine and a large Western Territory, which includes modern day Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Wisconsin and Minnesota.

The map is richly annotated with Indian information, early western settlements, and other details. The 1795 Boundary Line from the Treaty of Grenville is present. A number of forts appear in the Upper Midwest. Interesting annotations along the Mississippi River.

One of the best maps of the US to appear in the first decade of the 19th century.
