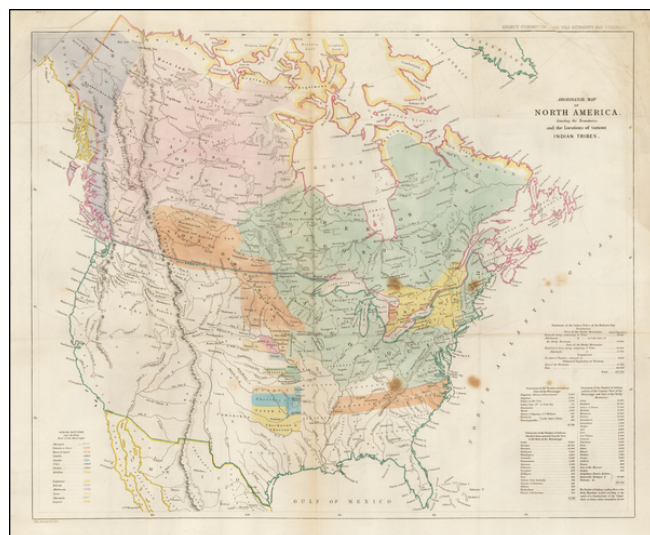
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Aboriginal Map of North America, denoting the Boundaries and the Locations of various Indian Tribes.

Description:

Finely executed map published by a British Parliamentary Committee report on the Hudson's Bay Company.

The map provides an exceptional overview of the location of the Indian Nations in North America, with the exception of the western part of the United States. The table notes 14 Indian tribes formerly east of the Mississippi, most of whom have been resettled to the west, with 3 (Catawba, Uchee and Natchez) noted as "extinct." Separate tables show the populations of various nations.

The parliamentary report for which the map was prepared resulted in the HBC being stripped of their exclusive rights in south central Canada (in the provinces of Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba), with the land being turned over to Canada for settlement.
