Scarce map of Mexico, Upper California and contiguous parts of the Southeastern US, naming Texas, but pre-dating its republic period..

The present map is the first edition of Lizar's map, which in a later edition would name the "Republic of Texas." The map also bears a note stating: *Note* . . . *The boundary between Mexico on the north and the United States is a line drawn from Cape Mendocino, (Lat.* 40° 28' 40") *Eastward to the Rocky Mountains. Mines indicated by cross, thus* +.
