Scarce map of Galicia, published by Nicolas de Fer in Paris.

De Fer's map is marvelously engraved in the style unique to De Fer, with excellent emphasis on the topographical details of Galicia, especially the depiction of the mountains in the region. Includes a decorative cartouche and coat of arms.

Nicolas de Fer (1646-1720) was the youngest son of Parisian print and map seller, Antoine de Fer [d.1673]. He became an official geographer to both French and Spanish kings. Nicholas de Fer was one of the most prolific and influential French geographers and cartographers of the late 17th and early 18th Century. The present example was issued by Louis-Charles Desnos, the successor to De Fer.
