

Rare map of Los Angeles and promotional pamphlet given to attendees traveling to the National Education Association (NEA) convention in Los Angeles in the Summer of 1899.

The map covers Downtown Los Angeles, China Town, etc, extending north to Elysian Park, west to the Evergreen and IOOF Cemeteries, south to Santa Monica Avenue (later Blvd), and west to Arlington.

The lines of the Southern Pacific RR and several interurban lines shown, with High School, Court House, Post Office, City Hall, Chamber of Commerce, Hebrew Cemetery, and numeous train depot's shown.

The pamphlet is illustrated with images showing the places of interest in California and the trip west.
