A massive Wayne County dominates the south. A number of early towns are shown, primarily along the Missouri and Mississippi Rivers, although no sign of Kansas City. Liberty, Ft. Osage, Buffton, Lexington, Jefferson, Charitson, Franklin and Boone are all shown on the western part of the Missouri, as is Ft. Osage. One of the earliest separate maps of the state published outside of America and a fascinating map of the state, shortly after statehood. Gorgeous full color example.
