

Important early sea chart of Puget Sound, published by the US Coast Survery

This chart shows Puget Sound and spans from Olympia north to Utsalady on Camano Island. The sound is filled with islands, soundings, bottom types, ports, anchorages, inlets, and more. Seattle is named even though it was briefly disincorporated in 1867, the year the map is dated.



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The chart precedes the establishment of Tacoma.

Numerous navigational notes appear, including tables on lighthouses and tides.
