The map focuses on showing Texas and Upper California (New Albion and New California), showing the Spanish Intendencies of San Luis Potosi, New Mexico, Durango and Sonora, among others.

Includes the mythical lakes of Timanagos and Teguayo on the River Buenaventura, which reached from San Francisco Bay to Salt Lake.

The Carnacaways Indians are shown in Texas, as is St. Antonio and St. Jose, along with Galveston, Loredo, Mier and other early place names. Many Indian names included.
