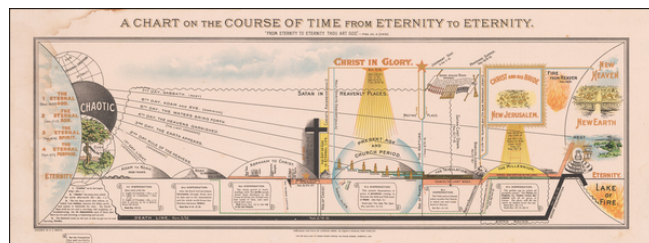

Description:

Original, large pictorial chromolithograph of history showing six dispensations, published and sold by Loizeaux Brothers in New York and also distributed through the "Home Friend Office" in Toronto.

The lithograph presents a schematic view of the history of the world, as understood in Dispensationalism. The separation of time into stages and cycles is central to Dispensationalist theology, and thus Dispensationalism lends itself to interpretation and representation through visual timelines.

Writing decades after the publication of the chart, a reviewer said of Booth's *Chart*:

A. E. Booth's "Chart of the Ages" has helped many thousands get a clear picture in their minds of the major events in biblical history—those of the past and those that are still future. While various scholars who believe in *dispensationalism* (as did A.E. Booth) may disagree with some details such as the number of dispensations or the *timing* of the first couple chapters of Genesis, the general view of this chart is not in dispute. This pamphlet, recently updated, is the best available to explain in some detail the events pictured on the chart.
