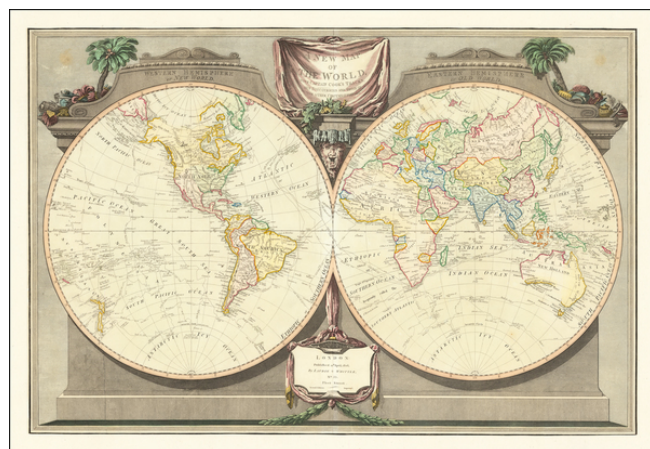

Striking example of the Laurie & Whittle map of the World, showing the tracks of Captain James Cook's 3 voyages, each in a different color.

The coastline of New Zealand is now completely formed, and while Australia's southern coastline is nearly complete, with Van Diemen's Land still attached to the continent.

Surrounded by an architectural border with the hemispheres adorned by a pediment identifying the Old and New Worlds. Decorated by a drape-style title cartouche surrounded by flora, native costumes and weaponry.

The map is surprisingly scarce on the market.
