Anti-America Historical School Map, Issued in the Final Year of the Soviet Union.

A fascinating school wall map of the United States, focusing on controversial aspects of American history in the 19th and early 20th century, published in Moscow in 1991 by the Committee on Geodesy and Cartography.

The map highlights major events in the early labor movement, such as strikes and the suppression thereof, and the creation of Native American reservations.

In the inset map in the lower-left corner, the foreign adventurism of the United States (termed by the map "Imperialist Aggression") is shown throughout Latin American and the Pacific.
