Scarce early map of Mexico, Upper California, Texas and Louisiana Territory.

The map extends on the west coast from San Francisco to Cabo San Lucas, with a detailed account of the Missions of Upper California, along with some of the settlements on the Gila and Rio Grande, extending north to Santa Fe and St. Lorenzo, but with a mythical town of Quivira shown.

Good detail in Texas, with the name Texas appearing.

An interesting time period, immediately preceding the reports of Alexander von Humboldt and Zebulon Pike, in the year prior to the Louisiana Purchase.
