

Detailed map of Texas (shown as a Republic), Upper California, The Rocky Mountains and contiguous regions.

The map includes extensive details in both Upper California and Texas, including roads, forts, Indians, towns, rivers and topographical details. The detail in Texas is exceptional, including missions and an extensive series of early roads.

Several lengthy notes describe the terrain in Upper California, pre-dating Fremont. The vestiges of the mythical California lakes can be seen.

Includes an oversized stove-pipe Texas extending to nearly Cheyenne Wyoming.

An essential map for Southwestern collectors, being perhaps the most widely disseminated map of the Southwest in Europe during the period.
