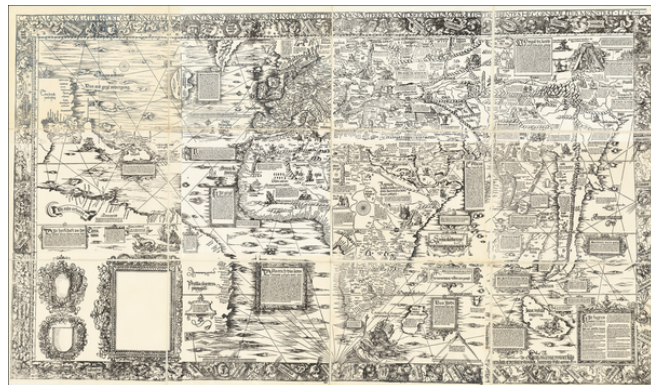

### **Description:**

This facsimile reproduction of Lorenz Fries' 1530 *Carta marina*, published in Munich in 1926, is the only known large-scale facsimile of that important world map.

Fries began work on a re-issue of Martin Waldseemüller's famous 1516 wall map (likewise called *Carta marina*) after completing work on the 1522 edition of Ptolemy.

Fries' map was apparently completed in 1525, but no complete example of that edition exists. See, Leo Bagrow [Fragments of the "Carta Marina by Laurentius Fries, 1524, IM XIV ('S-Gravenhage: Mouton & Co., 1959), p.111-2 (ill)] about the fragments in the University of Leiden Library.

The only known example of the 1530 map is held in the Bayerische Staatsbibliothek, Munich.
