

Marvelous regional map, extending from Port George and Cape San Sebastian to just Soledad Mission and Monterey, and centered on San Francisco, with a large depiction of the Bay. The most detailed regional map of the period. Over a dozen place names. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring. A fine unfolded and probably separately issued example of this pair of maps covering the Baja. Evidence of earlier foxing and a bit of soiling and spotting, but a good example for a collector.
