Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring. A fine unfolded and probably separately issued example of this pair of maps covering the Baja. A bit of soiling, otherwise a near fine example.
