

## **Description:**

Large British Admiralty chart of the Bahamas, focusing on Andros Island and the banks to the west of it. The chart was originally surveyed by Royal Navy officers in the 1830s and '40s, and was substantially updated in 1863 and 1907, with further updates to 1925.

In addition to Andros Island, the map shows New Providence and labels Nassau, Lyford Cay and other important landmarks on the island.

The publisher of the chart updated it in manuscript to 1938, which accounts for the red ink annotations throughout the map.
