

A Pomeiooc Village in Virginia

Interesting view of a native American settlement, based upon De Bry. Includes dwellings, domestic animals such as oxen and donkeys [?], palisades, guns or muskets, and council fire.

This image is derived from Theodor de Bry's *America*, Pt. 1, plate 19, where it illustrates the native American village of Pomeiooc in Virginia. De Bry's text identifies the building with the pagoda-like roof as the temple. Here a scene of agriculture or farming, palm trees, and pine trees is added to the image.

The view is drawn from the first comprehensive geographical dictionary of America in Italian.
