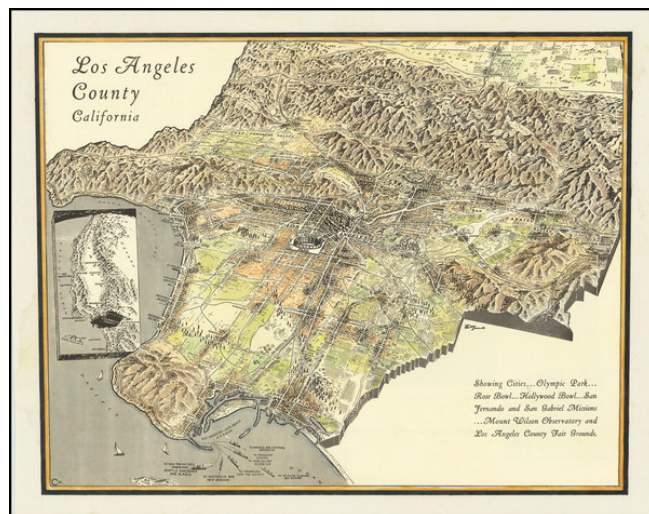

Description:

Interesting promotional map of Los Angeles County, likely published at about the time of the 1932 Olympics.

The center of the map and first item referenced is Olympic Park, which came to be known as the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum. The map spreads out in swaths of muted color, extending south to the harbor, north to the Hi Desert, west to Santa Monica Bay and East to the Pomona Fair Grounds.

Below the title, a rectangular slab is visible with a picture of the state of California on its surface. The portion of Los Angeles County has been highlighted on the state.
