

Detailed chart of the entrance to San Francisco Bay, including a plan of San Francisco.

The map extends south to Pt. Avisadero and north to Ballenas Bay.

The map includes Alcatraz and Yerba Buena Islands, and, halfway between the two, Blossom Rock, a submerged hazard to navigation discovered in 1827 by Captain Frederick Beechey of the Royal Navy, and named for His Majesty's Ship Blossom, then commanded by Beechey.

Includes tables of sailing directions, tides and other information.
