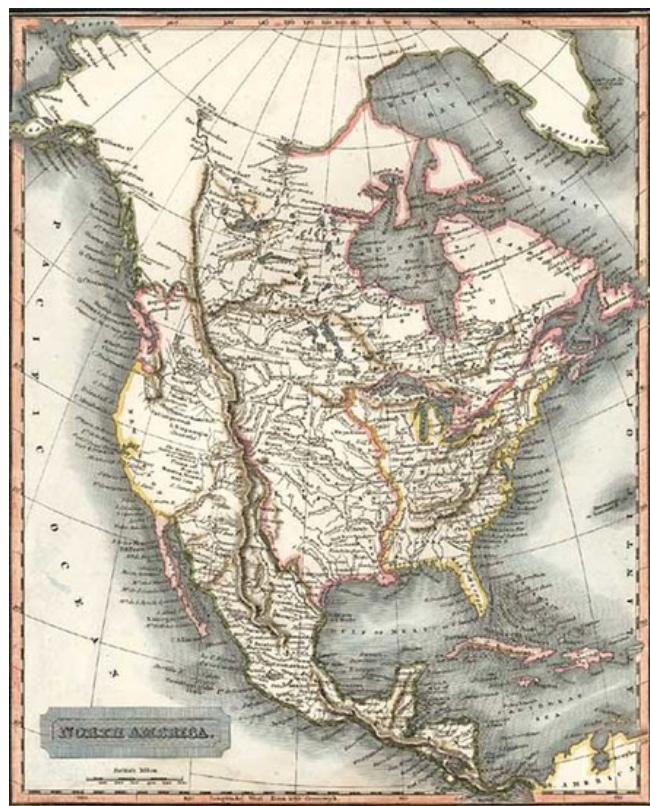

Description:

Interesting pre-Lewis & Clark map of North America. The discoveries of Cook and Vancouver along the NW Coast of America and Alaska are in evidence, but much of the mythical and conjectural cartography remains. Single cordillera for the Rocky Mountains, pre-dating Humboldt. Lake Timpanagos is shown, but labeled doubtful. The mythical rivers of the west are present, but truncated. A second western lake is noted, but without a western limit. Early Columbia River basin representation, based upon early British exploration. The map draws largely from early editions of Arrowsmith's seminal wall map of North America, used by Lewis & Clark during their expedition. Very narrow margins, sometimes touching neatline.
