Fine large map of the Gulf Coast, Florida, the Southeast, Caribbean, and Central America, exhibiting Cary's usual fine engraving and elegant hand coloring.

Georgia is depicted extending to the Mississippi River. East and West Florida are shown. "Cenis" is named in Texas. Many Indian tribes are located throughout the South. The Mujacos and Tocobagos are named in Florida. There is excellent detail in the Caribbean. Texas area shows the site where "Here Mr. La Salle settled in 1685" and "Here Mr. LaSalle was murdered in 1687".

Eight place-names in Texas. Numerous cliffs and forts are named on the lower Mississippi River such as "Davion's Rocks" or "Loftusis's Cliffs".

Detailed Condition:
