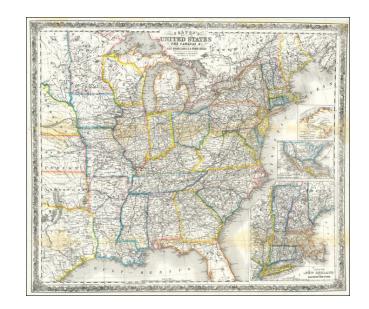

Civil War-era edition of J.H. Colton's pocket map of the United States.

As was almost universally the case at the time, Colton seldom acknowledged the Confederacy in his maps of the U.S., and this is no different.

The map includes parts of Canada, extends west to Texas, Indian Territory, Nebraska Territory, and Minnesota Territory, with insets of the whole United States, New England, and the Isthmus of Panama.

The focus of the map is on railroad and stage lines, but many towns, Indian names, forts, and other details appear.

Detailed Condition:

Fairly significant staining along the horizontal folds. Some wear along other fold lines, most notably along the vertical fold through the title. Black-cloth gilt-lettered covers titled "Colton's Map of the United States The Canadas &c. &c. J.H. Colton"
