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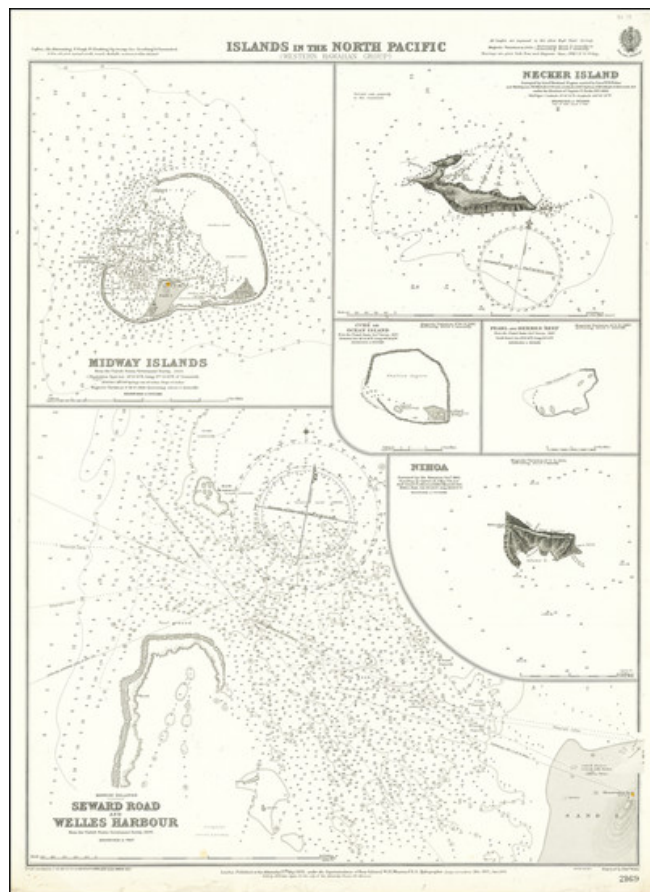

Interesting multi-part sea chart of the islands from the "tail" of Hawaii, including Midway Island. This chart was originally issued by the British Admiralty in 1895, this example is an updated version from 1924.

The chart includes charts of:

- Midway Islands From the United States Government Survey, 1900
- Necker Island Surveyed by Lieutt. Rowland Nugent assisted by Lieutt. F. H. Walter and Midshipmen...
- Cure or Ocean Island From the United States Govt. Survey, 1867.
- Pearl and Hermes Reef From the United States Govt. Survey, 1867.
- Nihoa Surveyed by the Hawaiian Govt. 1885.
- Midway Island Seward Road and Welles Harbour From the United States Government Survey, 1900.



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Some of these surveys were taken by the USS *Lackawanna*, which served in the Civil War before being sent to the Pacific to expand the reach of the U.S. there. She claimed numerous small islands and atolls for the United States during her decades-long cruise of the Pacific.
