

Whimsical local promotional map of the area centered on Roosevelt, Utah, published by its Chamber of Commerce.

Centered on Roosevelt (in Northwestern Utah), the map is dissected by Interstate 40 and shows recreational activities and local attractions.

Roosevelt's Annual Uintah Basin Industrial Convention (first week in August) and Ute Tribal Dances (July) are two of the annual events promoted. Other images include hunting, fishing, agriculture and local industry.

A number of photos on the verso compliment the typical chamber of commerce boosterism, including a reference to the mineral opportunities, including oil, natural gas, gilsonite, potash and uranium.
