



California During the Boom of the Late 1880s

Detailed map of California, published in Chicago by George Cram.

The map illustrates California's growing railroad system, which has finally spread through the entire state, with San Diego finally getting a local line between San Diego and Colton, California in 1882 and later a link to the transcontinental railroad in 1885.

Dozens of railroad lines are shown, with hundreds of stations located.

The map pre-dates the formation of Orange County, created in 1888.
