## **Description:**

Rare Covens & Mortier edition of Johann Jakob Lidl's map of Silesia, in modern-day Poland, issued in Amsterdam in 1748.

Highly detailed map of Silesia adorned with 2 large superb cartouches on 2 opposite corners of the map. The title cartouche is decorated with little angels and elements of the Silesian countryside. The cartouche containing the legend is surrounded mainly by agricultural and hunting tools.

The map is centered on *Breslau* (Wroclaw) and names hundreds of towns and cities. The map delineates duchies and features excellent topographical detail.

The map was engraved by Condet and signed by him in the lower-right corner.

## **Detailed Condition:**

Original outline color. Two sheets joined as one and dissected in 24 sections and mounted on old linen.
