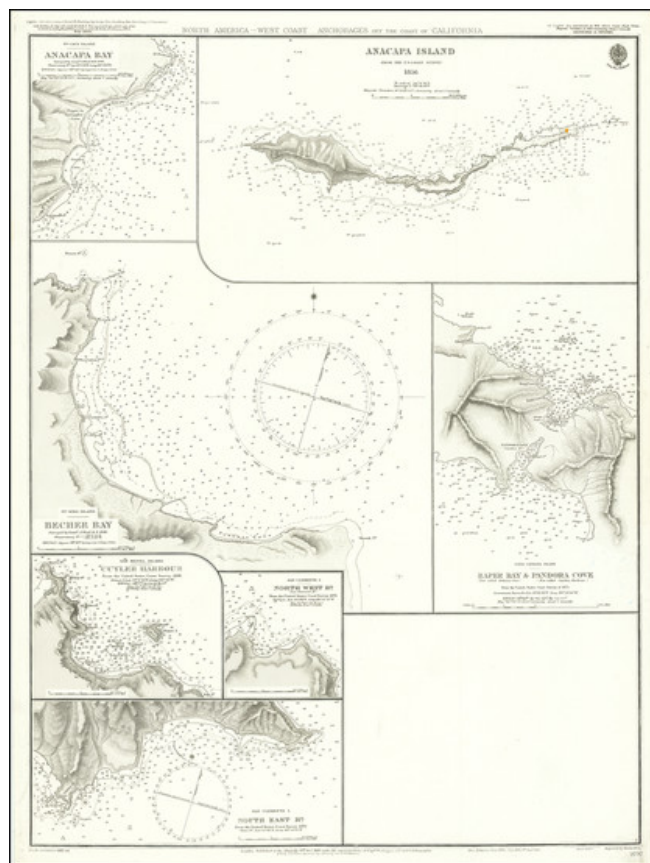

Description:

Rare antique sea chart of anchorages on islands in the Santa Barbara Channel, Santa Catalina, and San Clemente off the Pacific Coast of California.

The chart was issued by the British Admiralty first in 1860, using surveys from the previous decades by both the Royal Navy and American Coast Survey, and it was updated substantially over the following decades, up to this edition from 1921.

The chart includes the following inset maps:

- St. Cruz Island Anacapa Bay Surveyed by Lieutt. J. Wood R.N. 1848
- Anacapa Island From the U.S. Coast Survey 1856
- Santa Catalina Island Raper Bay & Pandora Cove (Now called Isthmus Cove) (Now called Catalina



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Harbour)

- San Clemente I. South East Hr. From the United States Coast Survey 1879
- San Clemente I. North West Hr. (San Clemente Hr.) From the United States Coast Survey, 1876.
- San Miguel Island Cuyler Harbour From the United States Coast Survey, 1896.
- Sta. Rosa Island Becher Bay Surveyed by Lieutt. J. Wood R.N. 1848

Altogether the map includes harbors on Santa Catalina, Anacapa, Santa Rosa, San Clemente, and San Miguel.
