Hieroglyphic Map of the Pilgrimage of the Aztecs to the Valley of Mexico

Scarce map showing the travels of the Aztec Tribes which led them to the Valley of Mexico, from Antonio Garcia y Cubas' monumental *Atlas Geographico, Estadistico e Historico de la Republica Mexicana*, the first atlas of the Mexican Republic.

The map employs the symbols of the Aztecs which were utilized in indigenous pre-Columbian maps to illustrate the journey.

The map includes a text explanation by Doctor Jose Fernando Ramirez, then Conservator of the National Museum of Mexico in the 1850s.

Antonio Garcia y Cubas was Mexico's first great map maker and his work is highly sought after.
