A Rare Louise Jefferson Pictorial Map

Rare pictorial map illustrating the distribution of the bible around the world via Bible Societies and similar organizations, drawn by African American artist Louise E. Jefferson for the National Council of Churches in 1947.

The map provides historical vignettes on important printings and other events in the history of the Bible, such as the first American Bible (1638), first Indian Bible (1661-63), John Wycliffe translation of the Vulgate into English (1380-84), St. Jerome Latin Bible (the Vulgate) translated from the original tongues to at Bethlehem (circa 405), Jonathan Gable translation of St. Matthew into Japanese and printed on woodblocks in Yokohama (1871), etc.
