Description:

Original, 17th-century Jansson carte-a-figures map of Denmark, published in Amsterdam. and showing the Jutland Peninsula.

The map shows the country in full, includes a portrait of Tycho Brahe bottom center, and is surrounded by city views of:

- Coppenhagen
- Elsenor
- Lantskroon
- Ripen
- Veraniburgum
- Oldenborgh
- Lubeck
- Hamburg
- Sleswyck
- Cronenburg

Danish coat of arms and costumed figures on either side of the map.



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The map on the verso is entitled *Ducatus Luneburgensis Adiacentiumqu regionum delineatio Auctore Iohanne Mellingero*. This map extends from Hamburg to Wolfenbuttel, showing the lower Albis River. Bremen, Lunenburg, Nienborg, Brunswig, Magedburg and Oldenburg also appear on the map.
