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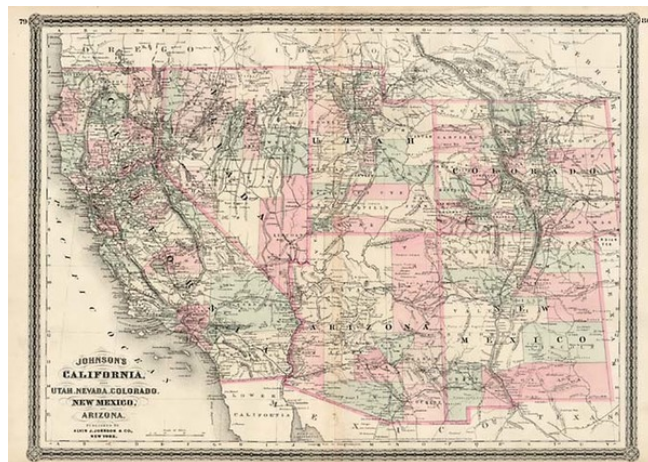

One of the most interesting features of this edition is the inclusion of numerous mining districts in Southeastern California. The number of roads, railroads, towns, settlements, and other details in the map has increased dramatically over the early years, although many counties are still not named. Lots of details on gold and silver mining in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah and Arizona. Worthy of extensive study. Johnson's map of the West is one of the most interesting and collectable maps of the period. The maps were updated annually or more often, showing profound territorial boundary changes and county formations from year to year and even within a single year. A comprehensive collection of maps of the American West is incomplete without a good run of these maps. A nice example with good margins. The late editions of the map rarely appear on the market.
