## The Kingdom of Naples at the end of the 16th-Century

Attractive antique map of the Kingdom of Naples with its coastal islands, major cities, mountains, and rivers.

This work is from the so-called Cologne School of mapmaking, the members of which made a concerted, though largely unsuccessful, attempt to supplant Antwerp (and to a lesser extent Amsterdam) as a mapmaking hub in the 1590s and first decades of the 17th century. Cologne's role as a mapmaking center was boosted by Dutch and Flemish refugees fleeing persecution and war, just as Amsterdam was boosted by those leaving Spanish-controlled Antwerp after 1588.

#### **Rarity**

Metellus's maps are very rare on the market. This is the first time we have handled this map. We find no other examples in OldMaps nor in RBH.
