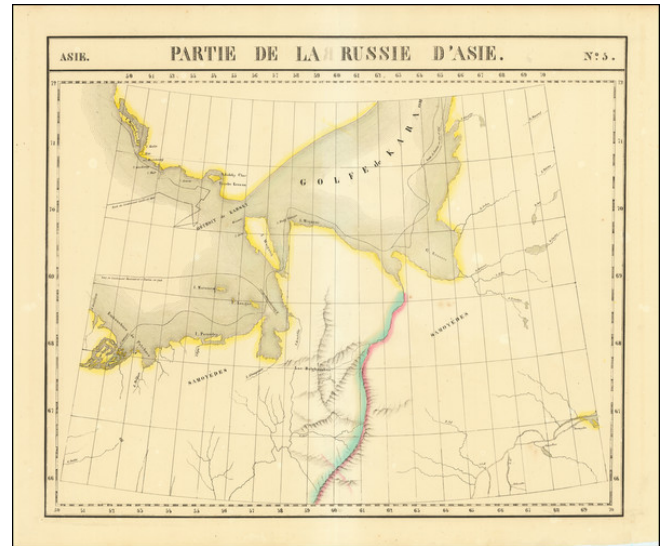

Description:

Attractive original antique map of the far northern coastline of Russia just above the Ural Mountains, originally appearing in Vandermaelen's *Atlas*.

The map shows the southernmost portion of Novaya Zemlya, known as Yuzhny Island. The coastline of the island is little mapped, and mostly guessed at. The mouth of the Pechora River is visible to the west and the start of an extensive promontory can be seen to the east. The map shows routes taken by famous explorers.

Vandermaelen's monumental *Atlas* accomplished was the first atlas to map the world on a uniform scale. Published in six volumes, each sheet could be combined as individual gores to complete an immense globe.
