## **Description:**

Scarce antique engraved map of the Dalmatian coast, covering parts of present-day Croatia and Bosnia & Herzegovina. The map was published by Pierre Mariette, successor to Sanson, in Paris in 1703.

At the center of the map is the Republic of Ragusa, which was an aristocratic maritime republic whose capital was Dubrovnik (here called "Ragusi nuovo als Dobronika Turc"). The Republic was eventually subsumed into Italy, in 1808, during the reign of Napoleon.

## **Detailed Condition:**
